It is good to be back in the beautiful and familiar surrounds of Sts Peter and Paul's church to gather as a community of faith. Although as I pen these confidence words work is still being completed. I think it was Winston Churchill who said we construct and shape buildings and then they shape us. In December 2026 it will be 100 years since our church was blessed and opened. Through all those years and in unbelievable changing times Sts Peter and Pauls has been a reassuring space for prayer and worship. It is a place made holy by the Spirit filled people of God and the faithfulness of our loving God.

My sincere thanks to Realm Builders who have overseen the repair works. The southern ceiling which was badly damaged by termites is now safer and looking as good as new. The next major work to be done is the repainting of the interior walls. This was done in 2016 but the smooth stone and plaster surfaces require a better primer so that the final coat lasts longer. This will be a costly exercise but unless done properly we will soon be back to where we are now.

The church is becoming the cultural hub of the district. Last week it was movie making and next week a music concert. You are invited to attend a concert at Sts Peter and Paul's next Friday 21st June at 7.30PM with performances by One Equal Music. Details with the weekly email.
