Twelfth Sunday in Ordin<mark>ary Time</mark>

Do you ever feel as the disciples of Jesus felt as described in the Gospel of today? Storms are raging all around us. Fearful that direction, safety or security is to be found nowhere. Even Jesus is absent -as if asleep. It is important to remember that Jesus does not chide his followers for waking him. He was disappointed at their lack of faith. So, amid whatever storm we may find ourselves we make time in prayer to wake the sleeping Jesus, who after all is in the boat with us, and share the worries and concerns that make us fearful.

When a parent names their child after a family member or noted person, it is usually to both honour the older individual and to instil in the child the qualities they admired. A special bond exists between them. Although, in a society of increasing individualism the quest to impart names that are unique and connected to nothing is now verging on the ridiculous. Our faith community honours Peter and Paul – saints of obvious and well-known flaws and failings - and yet through them the grace of God did extraordinary things. We who carry their names have, through that same grace, the opportunity to live as they did. We grow in faith; we share the love of Jesus with others, and we all, like them, rely on the endless mercy of God.

Next week after each Mass you are invited to join fellow parishioners to honour Peter and Paul and share some social time together. Those attending supper after the 5.30 Saturday evening Mass are asked to please bring a plate.

THIS WEEK'S ACTION

FEAST OF ST PETER AND ST PAUL - next week we celebrate the solemnity of our parish's patron saints.

St. Peter was one of the original Apostles. He was a fisherman before he was called to follow Jesus. Originally, Peter's name was Simon. Jesus asked the apostles, "Who do you say that I am?" Simon said, "You are the Messiah, the son of the living God." Jesus then said: "Blessed are you Simon, Son of Jonah, for flesh and blood have not revealed this to you but my heavenly Father. And so I say to you, you are Peter and upon this rock I will build my church and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."

St. Peter is the patron saint of fishermen. He is considered the first Pope of the Catholic Church.

St. Paul was not one of the original apostles. While persecuting Christians after the death of Jesus, he was thrown to the ground by a bright light. He heard a voice asking him, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" He responded with "Who are you, Lord?" Jesus answered him: "I am Jesus whom you are persecuting. But get up and enter the city and you will be told what you are to do." Paul was blinded by the light for three days after which scales fell from his eyes. He then joined the apostles and became known as "The Apostle of the Gentiles". He wrote many of the letters in the New Testament.

St. Paul is the patron saint of writers, the press, and missionaries.
