The Most Holy Body and <mark>Blood of Christ</mark>

This Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, better known by most as Corpus Christi, is unashamedly a very Catholic celebration. First suggested by St Thomas Aquinas it gives the people of God an opportunity to focus on this precious gift of Christ's continuing presence among us and all the joy and hope that pours forth from such a gift. Holy Thursday every year recounts Christ's institution of the Eucharist, which is the sealing forever of the Covernant of forgiveness between God and us and which is lived out in the passion of Good Friday when his blood of Christ is indeed poured out.

Corpus Christi reminds us today that in our lives and in our streets the Covernt or promise of love still nourishes and feeds the Body of Christ on earth to continue the mission of Christ. The Eucharist is a "living sacrifice" breathing life into us as we follow the example of Lord and Master in serving others in love. The Eucharist is the real presence and encounter with the love, perseverance, energy, healing and compassion of Christ himself. When sharing in the Table of the Lord or praying before the Blessed Sacrament the encounter with Christ is real and life giving.

The annual Corpus Christi procession, which is growing in popularity each year, takes place today, Sunday, at 2.00pm. It begins at the Cathedral and then proceeds through the streets of Brisbane. All are most welcome to participate as we do a very "Catholic" thing.

SOCIAL JUSTICE NEWS: Update on the STEP UP Project

In 2020, the Parishioners of Sts Peter and Paul raised over \$20,000 to help refugees detained by the Australian Government on Manus Island to resettle in Canada as part of the ADS Up initiative "Operation Not Forgotten". The process has been drawn out over recent years, with other international refugee crises being prioritised by the relevant authorities. However, the Parish has recently been informed by ADS Up, that our funds have now been successfully used to resettle an Iranian man (now in his mid-30s) in Alberta, Canada. This man witnessed atrocities in the Iranian Army and had to flee the country by boat, only to face a decade of detention on Manus Island. He can now move on with the next phase of his life in freedom, thanks to the generosity of Parishioners.
