Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The day it snowed in Bulimba – see image inside.

There was a hive of activity around the entrance to Sts Peter and Paul’s church. Nearly forty people were busy for most of the day. In fact, two large vans arrived the night before with their own security service and ‘shooting’ continued until late that evening. During the grey overcast day, the air was filled with regular shouts of “Quiet on set, annnnd Action”! Who knew that those threatening clouds would drop several centimetres of snow before the end of the day.

A joint project of a Brisbane film studio based in Hemmant and an American Company who produce family suitable movies have been busy filming ‘A Vintage Christmas’ at several locations around the southern suburbs. We were asked if the entrance to Sts Peter and Paul’s could be used as one of the sets due to its historic nature and beauty. The movie is set in North America and stars two Canadian actors, one of whom was in ‘Star Trek: Discovery’.

I think it is important, when appropriate, to assist such projects and cooperate with the wider community especially when we have a church of such beauty and significance. There was also a small financial reimbursement. I’m grateful to the builders who continued the repair work during the day. In fact, they make an appearance!

The final scene, a kiss on the balcony in the snow, may have made Peter and Paul blush but I look forward to the final product. The company was keen to keep us in mind for future projects, but I told them unless it is a commercial with Alfie Langer we’re not interested. I managed to get Sts Peter and Paul’s mentioned in the credits so I advise you all to get an Agent!
